- 1. [redacted] Pal Bib Mirakaj and Nikoll Gjommarkaj were welcomed to Belgrade with what the informant describes as full official honors and were given hospitality at the Hotel Moskva.
- 2. Pal Mirakaj subsequently met with functionaries of an unspecified Yugoslav ministry, who told him:
 - a. The Yugoslav Government, which originally opposed Mirakaj and has tried to "eliminate" him, has changed its attitude and is pleased by his arrival in Yugoslavia. Not only Mirakaj, but the BKI leaders in general, are held in great esteem.
 - b. Mirakaj and his followers will be aided in overthrowing the Hoxha regime.
 - c. The Albanian people will be free to choose their own government, and Yugoslavia will not meddle in the country's internal affairs.
 - d. The Prizren Committee¹ has not yet assumed final form.
