

Rome, 2nd November 1949

Very honest and loving friends,

The mission started in February of this year by Ndue Pjeter Gjomarkaj and Ndue Melyshi unfortunately did not give us the desired results, not because of absence of ability and bravery on their part, as they deserve the biggest honour, but for completely technical reasons.

After eight months of intense work, we managed to get the mission started and running once again. For this purpose, nine brave men have approached us voluntarily, determined to follow the example of their ancestors, which means to go in support of the Resistance.

I know your sufferings and sacrifices, and every day I have it is on my mind, so believe me that I have worked with all the power I have had along with my friends, to come to your support and I will not rest for as long as I live, but will continue to work in this direction.

For this reason, I advise to form the Mirdita Executive Committee, which will emerge as the only national government authority in our country. Advise you to do your best to set up Radio communication because without it everything is a struggle.

To speed up the organization of these groups, harmonize the brotherhood and from time to time to keep us informed and from here you will receive all the correct instructions

Wishing you success in this task, I greet you and I miss you and through you all the people of Mirdita, who in such difficult times have known how to stand up and fight, have known to hold high the flag of Tradition.
